Cases are considered injury deaths where the death was caused by an external mechanism, such as a transport incident, drug toxicity or drowning.

Injury deaths occurred in a higher proportion of males than females. The majority of male deaths occurred in those aged 45 - 64 years, and females in those aged 25 - 44 years.




Figure 1. Frequency of injury deaths by age group and sex, 2018 $\,$




Figure 2. Rates of injury deaths per 100,000 by ethnicity, 2018

The national rate of injury deaths was 19.8 deaths per 100,000 population. Injury deaths of Maori people was higher than the national rate, at 31.7 deaths per 100,000 (Figure 2).

32.7% of all injury deaths occurred in people aged between 45 and 64 years







Figure 3. Percentage of injury deaths by intent, 2018

The majority of injury deaths were unintentional, and more than one third (36.7%) were classified as intentional self-harm (Figure 3).

The highest frequency of injury deaths were transport-related (31.2%). The majority of fall-related deaths occurred in older people aged 65 years and above. The highest frequency of transport-related deaths occurred in people aged 25 - 44 years. The majority of firearm-related deaths occurred in men.
